- Paper: Shimmery White #101910, Whisper White #100730, Melon Mambo #115920, Basic Black #121045
- Other: Black Embossing Powder #109133, Heat Tool #129053, Aqua Painters #103954,
 2 3/8 Scallop Circle Punch #118874, Washi Label punch #138296, Dimensionals #104430

Measurement:

Melon Mambo: 5 ½" x 8 ½"
Basic Black layer: 4" x 5 ¼"

• Shimmery White layer: 3 3/4" x 5"

Whisper White scrap

Instructions:

- 1. Stamp Flower image and sentiment using Basic Black Ink.
- 2. Sprinkle Black Embossing Powder and heat set.
- 3. Using Agua Painter wet the flower area and leaves.
- 4. Then pick up the colors using the Aqua Painter and color flower and leaves as shown.
- 5. Come back with less water and give darker highlights to the flower and leaves.
- 6. Stamp clusters of dots with Pink Pirouette around flower.
- 7. Punch scallop from the center of the Basic Black. Cut in half to form a smaller circle to fit better on the card.
- 8. Assemble all layers when water coloring is dry.
- 9. Attach Black scallop with dimensionals.
- 10. Stamp sentiment and punch out using Washi Label Punch add to Black Scallop.
