

Happy Vehicle Card

Featured Paper Pumpkin Kit:

- Many Happy Birthdays, February 2017

Additional supplies used:

- 100867 Night of Navy Cardstock
- 122924 Pool Party Cardstock
- 141653 Window Sheets
- 101406 Jet Black StazOn Ink
- 107301 Whisper White Envelope
- 126889 Stampin' Trimmer
- 119869 ½" Circle Punch
- 135346 Project Life Corner Punch
- 104332 SNAIL Adhesive
- 103683 Glue Dots
- 104430 Dimensionals
- 141897 Wink of Stella Clear

Instructions:

1. Use trimmer to cut a 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" piece of Night of Navy cardstock. Then cut an 8" x 5-1/4" piece of Pool Party cardstock. Fold it in half and attach it to the Night of Navy piece to form the card base.
2. Trim a patterned cardstock piece in the kit to form the van/bus shape... cut along the long score lines, then cut the middle piece about mid-way through. Use the corner punch to round off the top corners of the van/bus.
3. Use the StazOn ink pad to swipe black ink across the tabs to form wheels.
4. Add a 1" x 2-1/2" piece of Window Sheet to the back with Glue Dots to create a "glass" back window.
5. Cut a 5/8" by 1-1/4" rectangle from a left-over piece of white cardstock in the kit. Stamp with the word "HAPPY" and add to the back of the van/bus using Dimensionals.
6. Ink up some scrap white from the kit with the Flirty Flamingo ink spot. Punch out two ½" circles and add to the back of the van/bus using Dimensionals. Color with Wink of Stella to give these taillights a little sparkle.
7. Attach the van/bus at a slight angle to the card front to give the appearance of movement.
8. Punch out some more ½" circles from the white scraps. Add in clusters to the card front to create exhaust.
9. Write or stamp on the inside before giving the card to someone. (It will fit into a medium envelope.)
