

## “Thanks a Latte” Bookmark Card



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### Stampin' Up Supplies:

- STAMPS – Coffee Café Bundle (145331)
- PAPER – Thick Whisper White (140272), Early Espresso (119686), Emerald Envy (131415), Coffee Break Designer Series Paper (144155)
- INK - Early Espresso (126974), Emerald Envy (141396)
- OTHER – Stampin' Trimmer (126889), Scallop Tag Topper Punch (133324), Big Shot (143263), Emerald Envy Crinkled Seam Binding (144190), SNAIL Adhesive (104332), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)

### Cutting & Scoring:

- Thick Whisper White – 8 ½" x 5 ½", score and fold at 4 ¼" and 2 ½" x 3"
- Emerald Envy – 2" x 5 ½" and 2 ½" x 3"
- Early Espresso – 1 ¾" x 5 ½"
- Coffee Bean DSP – 1 ½" x 5 ½"
- Whisper White – 2" x 2 ½"
- Emerald Envy Ribbon – (2) 8"

### Instructions:

- Place the White cardstock in the Stampin' Trimmer with the 5 ½" side at the top at 2". Place the cutting blade at the 8" mark on the arm and lower onto the cardstock. Slide trimmer blade up to the 6 ½" mark. Move the cardstock to the 1 ¼" measurement, lower the arm and repeat cutting. This will create a slit in the paper for your bookmark.
- Layer the Emerald Envy, Early Espresso, and Designer Paper together. Punch with Scallop Tag Topper. Insert ribbon. Slide the bookmark into the slit.
- Stamp “Thanks a Latte” in Early Espresso ink on the left side of the 2 ½" x 3" White cardstock. Die cut a coffee cup and the sentiment.
- Stamp the lid of the coffee cup in Emerald Envy ink on the left side of the 2 ½" x 3" Emerald Envy cardstock. Die cut a lid and the embossed sleeve.
- Adhere the cup together, adding the sentiment with a Stampin' Dimensional.
- Place (2) Dimensionals on the left end of the slit and add the coffee cup to the card.
