Stampin' Up! Supplies:

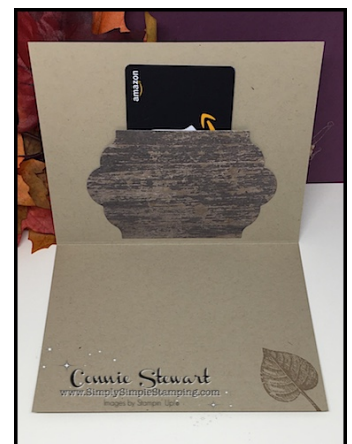
- STAMPS – Stylized Birthday (141828 Wood Mount), Vintage Leaves (138802)
- PAPER – Crumb Cake (120953), Wood Textures Designer Series Paper Stack (DSP) (144177)
- INK – Early Espresso (126974), Crumb Cake (126975)
- OTHER – Lots of Labels Framelits (138281), Big Shot (143263), Jute Twine (144625), Glue Dots (103683), Stampin Dimensionals (104430), Gift Card

Cutting & Scoring:

- Crumb Cake – 8 ½" x 5 ½", score and fold at 4 ¼"
- Wood Textures DSP – 4" x 5 ¼"

Instructions:

- Die cut the 2 ½" x 4 ¼" Lots of Label framelit from the center of the Designer Series Paper.
- Lay but don't adhere the DSP to the front of the card. Stamp Happy Birthday in Early Espresso ink in the center. Stamp a few leaves in Crumb Cake ink.
- Tie the jute twine in a knot on the right side of the die cut DSP. Trim off excess. Wrap a small piece around the left side and adhere with 1-2 Stampin' Dimensionals. This will give the illusion that the ribbon is going all the way through the card.
- Add Dimensionals all around the edges of the DSP and adhere to the front of the card.
- Place Glue Dots on the ends of the die cut, (3) along the bottom, and (1) in each corner on the top. Be careful and keep them close towards the outside so that your gift card will fit. Adhere close to the score line in the top of the card, inside.
- Insert the gift card.
