



(6) Chocolate Square Treat Holders

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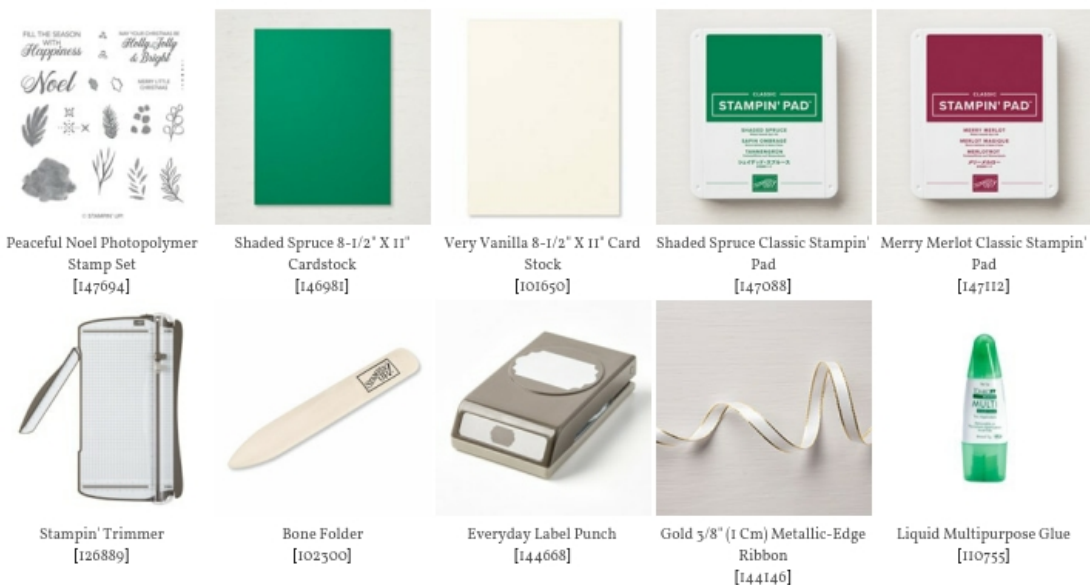
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Supplies:



Measurements:

- Shaded Spruce - 8 ½" x 11"
- Very Vanilla - 4" x 8 ½"
- Gold Metallic Edge Ribbon - (6) 16" pieces
- Ghirardelli Chocolate Squares - 18

How to Create Six Chocolate Square Treat Holder:

1. In Shaded Spruce ink, stamp sentiment (6) times on the 4" x 8 ½" Very Vanilla cardstock. Punch with the Everyday Label punch.
2. Stamp the (3) tiny berries in Merry Merlot ink around each sentiment. Set aside.
3. In Shaded Spruce ink, stamp the leaf image randomly all over the 8 ½" x 11" Shaded Spruce cardstock.
4. **CUT** 2" x 11", leaving 6 ½" x 11". Cut the 2" x 11" to 2" x 6 ½". The remaining cardstock is scrap.
5. **SCORE** the 2" x 6 ½" cardstock at 1", 2 ¾", 3 ¾", and 5 ½" (see diagram below). **SCORE** the 6 ½" x 11" the same.
6. Cut 6 ½" x 11" into (5) 2" x 6 ½" pieces.
7. Burnish all the scored lines with the bone folder.
8. Place (3) chocolate squares inside the holder and adhere with Multipurpose Glue on one end.
9. Tie the ribbon in a bow on the left side.
10. Adhere a label under the ribbon.
